- 8. April 27, noon Elections opens

- 1. Offices open for nomination are as follows: District Deputy, President, Vice President, Recording Secretary, Financial Secretary, Treasurer, Sargent-at-Arms, Junior Knights Director, and Seven (7) Area Representatives to the Board.
- 2. Nominations will occur electronically from April 13, 2024 at 6:00 am through April 21, 2024 at 11:59 pm via the Western States District website.
- 3. Delegates of the Western States District Conference will be permitted to nominate candidates.
- 4. Nominating statements, if any, shall not exceed 200 words and can be included on the nomination form when nominating candidates electronically.
- 5. Nominations for each office will be communicated to all delegates and to the membership on the Western States District website.



#### 2024 WSDC Knights Election Campaign Rules


- Every Knight in the Western States District who is financial, and their Council has paid the Western States District dues and assessments, is eligible to run for an Office on the Western States District Conference Board.
- 2. In conjunction with the candidates' forum, candidates will be allowed to post campaign material on the Western States District website. Candidates are encouraged to email their information to <u>kpcwsdc.knights.elections@gmail.com</u> for distribution to the membership. Campaign material can include but will not be limited to the following:
  - a. Flyers
  - **b.** Pictures
  - c. Resume of Qualifications





### 2024 WSDC Knights Election Rules

- 1. Officers to be elected are as follows: District Deputy, President, Vice President, Recording Secretary, Financial Secretary, Treasurer, Sargent-at-Arms, Junior Knights Director, and Seven (7) Area Representatives to the Board.
- 2. Eligible voters/delegates shall be qualified as indicated by the report of the Credentials Committee.
- 3. All Officers shall be elected by electronic ballot and there will be no absentee voting.
- 4. Electronic election of Officers shall take place on April 27, 2024 at 12:00 pm until 2:00 pm, unless otherwise directed.
- 5. Delegates will be sent an email with instructions and "Unique Access Key" on the morning of April 27, 2024 and no later than 12:00 pm.
- 6. Unique Access Key information is NOT to be shared with anyone unless the delegate is seeking technological assistance to vote. Delegates are allowed one vote per log-on. If not adhered to, the delegate will be disqualified from voting.
- 7. All Officers will be elected by a majority of votes cast. In the case of no clear majority, the names of the two candidates with the largest number of votes will be resubmitted to the delegates for a repeated balloting (runoff) to determine the winner.
- 8. If necessary, repeated balloting would take place on Saturday, April 27, 2024 as directed by the Elections Committee.
- 9. The Elections Committee will secure ballots until tallying is completed and the Elections Committee provides its report to the assembly.
- 10. All Ballots will be retained by the Conference for thirty days following the Election of Officers.
- 11. The report of the Election Committee shall be given immediately following the tally of votes.
- 12. The Elections Committee will monitor all phases of the election process.





#### Casting your Vote

(only registered delegates will be allowed to vote)

- Upon receipt of the email from "Knight of Peter Claver WSDC Knights <u>kpcwsdc.knights.elections@gmail.com</u>", click on the link provided within.
- 2. Click the Radical Button next to your candidate
- 3. Use the "Write in Feature" if your candidate is NOT listed
- 4. Click "Abstain" if you DO NOT WANT TO VOTE
- **5.** To Review/Change your vote click on the "Change Your Vote" Button
- **6.** Click "Submit" to cast your ballot

You will not be able to change your vote once "Submitted"

You will not be able to vote again once "Submitted"
